

GPMF 2025 Speaker FAQs

1. Who can submit speaker applications?

Application submissions are open to professionals, researchers, academics, and industry experts from around the world who are actively involved or have expertise in project management.

2. What topics are suitable for speaker application submissions?

3. How can I submit a speaker application?

4. What is the deadline for application submissions?

The deadline for application submission is **31 January 2025**. Late submissions will not be considered, so please check the timeline and submit your application before the stated deadline.

5. What criteria must be met to submit a winning speaker application?

Applications are assessed based on their originality, quality, objectivity, and relevance to the forum theme. Criteria include innovation, significance, clarity, and overall contribution to advancing knowledge in project management.

6. Can I submit more than one application?

Yes, you are allowed to submit more than one application, provided each submission adheres to the guidelines and focuses on a distinct topic.

7. When will I know if my application has been accepted?

You will be notified from **27 February 2025** onwards.

8. When will I need to submit my full presentation?

If you are accepted as a speaker, you will be required to submit your full presentation by **10 March 2025**.

9. What is the presentation format?

10. Do I need to submit my presentation in advance?

Yes, you need to submit your final presentation by **31 January 2025**. If there are any changes bring your presentation to the conference on a flash drive and submit the presentation at the Speaker Room. If your session has more than one speaker, please ensure the final combined presentation is submitted in advance to the speaker manager on communication@gpmf.world



11. Can I include video in my presentation?

Yes - if it's embedded in your presentation. Keep in mind though, Internet connections are not available at the speaker's podium, and hotspots are unreliable for streaming videos.

12. Will I have access to the Internet?

Our standard A/V set up DOES NOT include podium access to the Internet.

13. Do you have recommendations for my PowerPoint presentation?

We usually find that any font size less than 24 point is too small to be reasonably read in most presentation situations. We would prefer to see most text at a 28 or 32- point size, with titles being 36 to 44-point size. Charts and graphics with teeny tiny text are not super useful.

14. Will I be able to attend other sessions that I am not speaking at?

Speakers at GPMF 2025 are issued a speaker pass. This pass allows access to forum sessions, the exhibition show floor, and other programs.

15. Do you expect anything else from me besides showing up to speak?

We want your part of GPMF to be a phenomenal success. So we expect you to participate in a conference call to coordinate your session with the other speakers. We also hope that you will help promote your session. We will share with you a social media post design and caption to help spread the word about the forum and your participation.
